Game Notes

- SDSU won for the third time this season when trailing after six innings (3-13).
- The Aztecs are 14-6 in one-run games in 2018.
- This marked the first time this season SDSU has won a game played on Thursday.
- San Diego State tied a season-low for hits with five. Amazingly, the Aztecs have won twice when collecting five hits (also March 9 vs. Air Force).

Team Notes

- SDSU is now 21-6 in the Mountain West tourney since 2013.
- The Aztecs have won four of the five league tournaments during that span.
- San Diego State extends its MW tournament record win total to 48.
- The Aztecs win their third straight Mountain West Conference tourney opening game.
- San Diego State improves to 23-10 at Tony Gwynn Stadium this season.
- SDSU won its 84th consecutive game when leading after eight innings.
- The Aztecs have now gone 20 home games without dropping consecutive games.
- SDSU (entered today with a two-game losing streak) has now gone 137 straight games without suffering a three-game losing streak.
- The Aztecs last dropped three-straight games from April 29-May 1, 2016.
- SDSU snaps the Spartans three-game winning streak.

Series Note

- This marked the second time in 13 days that SDSU defeated the Spartans by a score of 2-1 at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- The Aztecs are 12-2 in their last 14 games against the Spartans.
- San Diego State improves to 3-0 against the Spartans in MW tourney play.
- SDSU leads the all-time series, 76-32 and lead the all-time series at home, 44-14.

Head Coach Mark Martinez

- In his fourth season, claims his 141st victory as a head coach (35.3 wins per season).
- Owns a 16-5 record in the MW tourney as the head coach.

Senior RF Chase Calabuig

1-for-2, GW RBI

- Reached base in 52 consecutive home games (Tony Gwynn Stadium record).
- Increased season batting average to a team-best .360.
- Reached base three times with a base hit, walk and hit by pitch.
- Tonight's GW RBI marked the 125th career RBI of his career.
- Has seven RBI in seven games against San Jose State this season.

Senior LHP Jacob Erickson

Win, 2.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K

- Made his MW and SDSU record and NCAA leading 118th career appearance.
- Recorded the final eight outs without allowing a hit or a walk.
- Improved to 3-0 in Mountain West Tournament play.
- This season against the Spartans, he has allowed two earned runs in 12.1 IP.

Junior RHP Garrett Hill

6.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 3 K

- Produced his longest outing since going 6.2 against Air Force on April 7.
- SDSU improves to 11-3 in his starts in 2018.
- The five hits allowed were his fewest in an outing since a three-hit, 8.1 IP performance against New Mexico on March 31.
- Has not suffered a loss in his last five appearances (four starts).
