

Stop the Sunrise Powerlink!

SDG&E/Sempra has continued to move forward on the Sunrise Powerlink despite numerous legal challenges. Not so fast! The first federal lawsuit against the line will be heard at the federal courthouse in San Diego at 2:30 pm on March 7th. Come show your support! Our rally will begin at Sempra HQ and move to the courthouse.

The Utilities Commission found the Powerlink to be one of the least environmentally sound alternatives. Local power was cited as the best option. The Commission judge said “deny it.” Lead Commissioner Dian Grueneich said it all in her dissent against the line: “Existing transmission lines will connect Sunrise to gas fired plants totaling over 1,000 MW of capacity in Baja California . . . Sempra owns one of these facilities,” and “Under any scenario that approves Sunrise, one group will still get benefits – SDG&E shareholders.”
